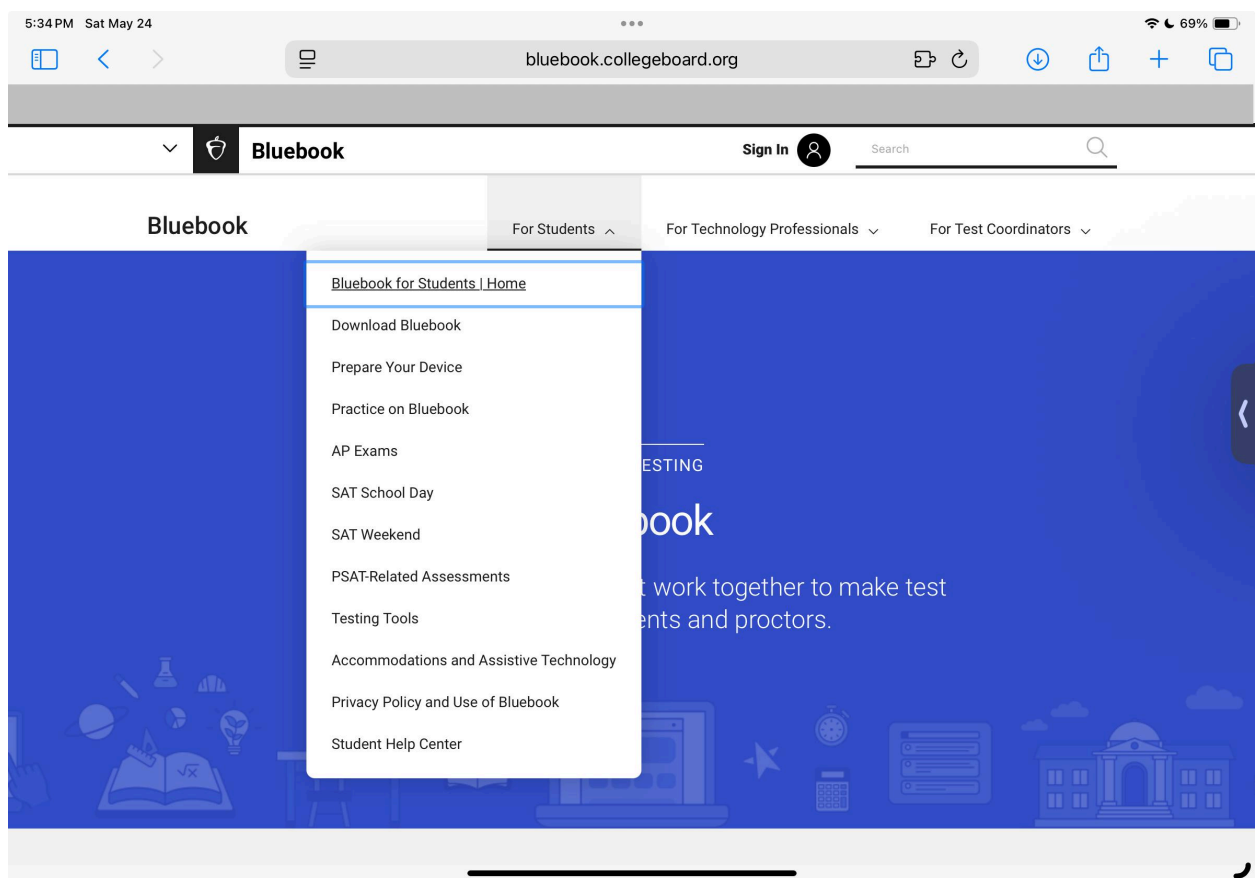


How to load Bluebook so that you can take a PSAT or SAT practice test.

1. Do you have a College Board account? You will if you have taken the PSAT, the SAT, or AP exams in the past. Go to Step 4.
2. If you don't have an account then go to the College Board website at [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org).
3. Signup for an account.
4. Then download the Bluebook app if you don't already have it.
  - a. Go to <https://bluebook.app.collegeboard.org> and click download for a Windows PC.
  - b. For an iPad or Mac go to the Apple Store and download the app.



5. Open the Bluebook app.
